This gathering of outdoor sports, recreation, health/fitness and travel enthusiasts is a unique in-person opportunity to reach thousands of active, interested adults and families from a wide area to promote your business, organization or event. Our top priority is making sure you have a successful Summer Expo.

EXHIBITOR DETAILS

Booth Move-In and Set-Up

Move-in and set-up is on Friday, 12-8pm and Saturday, 7-10am. All booths must be ready and aisles clear for the show opening at 10am. When you arrive, please check in at the show office in front corner of the Main Hall for your booth location. There will be a limited number of four-wheel carts available to help you move-in.

There are multiple entrances where you can move into the building. If you have a lot of stuff, the garage door near the City Center's electronic sign at 522 Broadway is a great option (there's a curb cut-out to pull your car onto the sidewalk or into the building). If the garage door is closed, enter the building just north via the glass doors, and a City Center staff will open it. There's also a loading dock on Maple Ave.

The City Center parking garage, located between Maple and High Rock avenues, has convenient, secure covered parking for 620 vehicles. The first hour is free, each additional hour is \$2, with a per day max of \$15. A pedestrian bridge to enter the City Center lobby is located on level 3. It is handicap accessible. There is also free parking nearby on streets and other parking garages.



The Saratoga Hilton, 534 Broadway, adjoining the Saratoga Springs City Center. Adirondack Sports has a block of 10 rooms per night over Fri, 3/15 and Sat, 3/16 at \$139 per night before 13% tax and \$12 parking (optional). Note: The reservation cut-off date is Tue, 2/12. Based on what you requested upon signup, you'll receive one 8'x2.5' or 6'x2.5' table and two chairs per 8x10 booth, unless arranged otherwise (if no request, 8' is the default). Please bring your own tablecloth. We'll have a limited number available to sign out at the show office (at the end of show, please return them to the office).

The booth has 8' pipe/drape at the back and 3' pipe/drape on the sides. This works well for hanging banners; decorators from Total Events will be on-site with "S" hooks for loan if needed. If you ordered and paid for electric service, your booth will have it. The City Center has public wi-fi and the building is secure during and after show hours. For name badges, bring your own or make your own at the show office (please return badge holders to the show office at the end of your shift or the show as we reuse them).

Booth Take Down and Move-Out

Booths should be taken down after the Expo closing on Sunday at 4pm. No exhibitor will be allowed to remove any portion of their exhibit prior to the Expo closing at 4pm. We keep the show hours tight and expect to be busy with attendees in the aisles until 4pm! All exhibits must be removed from the City Center on Sunday by 8pm.

Let them try, touch, see, feel, hear or taste it. Make sure there is a call to action to help you achieve your goal; something to inspire interaction between show attendees and your staff.
- Design your booth with a focus from the visitor's perspective. This is how they will scan the booth to determine if they should stop.
- Interactivity and creativity are encouraged at this high-energy show!

Booth Staffing

- Have the most positive, approachable and outgoing people staff your booth. Your booth staff's attitude will be the number one factor in the success of your participation as an exhibitor.
- Be sure your staff is qualified to answer all important questions about your organization.

Pre-Show Supply Checklist


Common items to have on hand:

Being well prepared will help pave the way to an enjoyable and successful show. Have fun and enjoy your weekend!








EXHIBITOR HAPPY HOUR
